THE FIRST MAPS ARE THE BASICS: Just Label these maps - no need to color

- **The Physical World** - Continents and Oceans (Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Australia, Europe, North America, South America and Arctic Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Indian Ocean, Pacific Ocean, Southern Ocean) ALSO draw in the Equator, Prime Meridian and the International Dateline
- **Rivers and Bodies of Water-** (Mississippi River, The Great Lakes smheo, St. Lawrence River, Rio Grande River, Caribbean Sea, Amazon River, Black Sea, Mediterranean Sea, Red Sea, Persian Gulf, Caspian Sea, Aral Sea, Lake Baikal, Thames River, Rhine River, Seine River, Nile River, Congo River, Tigris River, Euphrates River, Indus River, Ganges River, Mekong River, Yellow River, South China Sea)
- **Deserts and Mountain Ranges** - (Rocky Mountains, Appalachian Mountains, Andes Mountains, Alps Mountains, Aral Mountains, Caucasus Mountains, Himalaya Mountains and Sahara Desert, Kalahari Desert, Namib Desert, Siberia, Gobi Desert, The Outback; Australia's 4 biggest deserts)
- **Straits, Channels and Canals** - (Panama Canal, Strait of Gibraltar, English Channel, Suez Canal, Bosphorus Strait, Strait of Hormuz, Strait of Malacca, Strait of Magellan)
- **Regions of the World** - (North America, Latin America, Caribbean, Western Europe, Eastern Europe, Russia (Siberia), Central Asia, East Asia, South Asia, Southeast Asia, West Africa, Middle East (North Africa and Southwest Asia), Central Africa, East Africa, Southern Africa, Australia, Micronesia, Melanesia, and Polynesia)

THE SECOND SET OF MAPS ARE THE REGIONAL MAPS: These maps will be labeled and colored according to the directions

Directions:

- Draw and/or label the following political entities and physical features on each map.
- Complete **political and physical features** for each region. Make sure it is completed very neatly.
- Use the colors and symbols as outlined on the "Map Labeling Instructions" sheet for physical features (see attached).
- Outline or color each country in a different color than those bordering it on the map (lightly).
- Print neatly and as small as possible (keep it readable!).
- Draw arrows to less crowded areas of the map in order to label every item while writing from left to right (see example).
- Make sure the mouth of each river (the end of it) connects directly to another body of water.
- Use the Internet often, especially for rivers.
- Just label regions (Siberia, Patagonia, etc.) - do not draw anything.
