PLAGIARISM:

Don't do it.

To plagiarize is defined as taking ideas and writings of another and passing them off as one's own.

Students caught plagiarizing will be given a ZERO for the assessment or practice assignment.

Plagiarism includes:

- turning in **someone else's paper** as your own
- **copying** a friend's work before class (or having another teacher catch you copying work in his/her classroom)
- failing to properly **cite** a source
- copying an author's exact words and passing them off **as your own**
- **sharing your work with another student**

HOMEWORK POLICIES



***LATE or Redone WORK** is accepted until the Friday before the end of the quarter. No penalties will be given for late or redone work.

* Assessments and practice assignments will be able to be redone as per teacher requirements. Examples: corrections must be completed first, proof of study time submitted or required notes taken before submitting a re-do. Assessments must be redone in class.

READING REQUIREMENTS



*Students will be required to read personal novels each quarter, and complete a core-related project on each text.

Honors students are required to read an additional text.

Students should be ready to talk about their book at any time.

CHEATING...

*The teacher will notify the administration and contact parents if cheating is suspected.

*The student will be given a failing grade for that particular assessment or practice assignment.

CLASS NOVELS



Students will read, discuss and analyze a variety of novels in class this year. The novels were chosen to engage and challenge the students. Students should expect to complete practice assignments and complete a final assessment for each class novel/assigned reading. The expected novels for this year include:

- *Seedfolks* by Paul Fleishman
- *Death Coming up the Hill* by Chris Crowe
- *They Called Us Enemy* by George Takei
- Various short stories, graphic novels, poems and primary source documents.

Respect: *Students will maintain a **respectful and positive attitude** toward classmates and teacher. *Students will **be on time** to class.

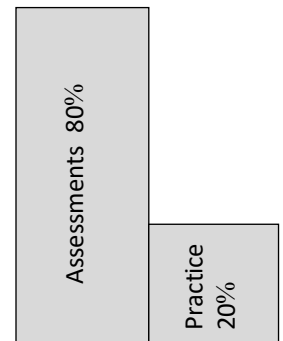
Behavior: *Students will stay engaged and participate in class. *Cell phones will stay out of sight unless permission is given to use them.
