### **Course Description and Objectives:**

Welcome to Sports & Outdoor Sewing 1! This is an introductory class in fabric selection and sewing techniques. Students will learn sewing vocabulary and the use of patterns, sewing machines, clothing construction and basic sewing equipment. The course is self-paced and time will be given for individual support.

#### **Supplies:**

- The \$10.00 class fee covers the cost of all patterns, classroom supplies, and machine maintenance.
- Please pay the class fee by Friday, August 26. You do not need to provide a receipt, the office will provide me with a list of students that have paid.

As soon as you have your materials purchased, you may bring them to class and store them in your storage tray. If you complete all 10 lessons (which include both projects) and still have time before the end of the semester, you will be given other project opportunities.

#### **Class procedures:**

- Use Canvas! This is a self-paced course and you will use Canvas to guide you through the course.

#### **Class Expectations:**

- 1. Students should put their best effort into their sewing lessons (10 for the semester)
- 2. All sewing work must be done at school. No sewing should be done at home.
- 3. Students need to supply all necessary project materials for their sewing projects.
