**Course Overview:**

- World Geography is a one-year high school course designed to help students develop a greater understanding and appreciation for the diverse cultural, economic, political, and geographic systems of the world. The class begins with a review of basic geography principles and continues with an in-depth study of specific geographic topics (Physical Geography, Population and Migration, Culture, Political Systems, and Economic Systems) regional maps, countries, peoples, and cultures of the world.

**Classroom Grading Policy:**

- Assignments are due at the beginning of the period unless otherwise noted. If students need additional help, I am available before and after school. Tests/Assessments are 80% of the grade. Assignments/Practice are 20% of the grade.
- Students may retake a final test within two weeks of the original test. They need to complete a test retake form and make sure all assignments for the unit are complete and turned in before retaking it.
- Students are expected to behave ethically. Cheating, sharing answers, copying assignments, or any other form of plagiarism is unacceptable. Students who participate in these activities will receive a “U” in citizenship and may not receive credit for the assignments or assessments related to the “cheating” behaviors.

**Classroom Late Work Policy:**

- Assignment due dates are listed on the calendar in the classroom and will be posted in advance on CANVAS and on Skyward.
- Late work must be fully completed to be accepted.
- Late work for each unit must be turned in no later than two weeks from the date of the original final test.

**Classroom Citizenship Guidelines:**

- Students are expected to be sitting at their correct desks when the bell rings.
- Cell phones are to be turned off and put away before entering the classroom. Earbuds need to also be put away unless needed for a class activity.
